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## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

## PRINT FABRICS:

-6 FAT QUARTERS
FROM EACH FAT QUARTER, CUT: - (20) @ $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 1/2"
-(6) @ $33 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$
-(6) @ $43 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 8^{\prime *}$
*THERE WILL BE EXTRA 4 3/8" PRINT SQUARES
BINDING FABRIC:

- 1/2 YARD


## BACKING FABRIC:

- 3 YARDS



## BACKGROUND FABRIC:

- 2 1/4 YARDS

FROM YARDAGE, CUT:

- (4) STRIPS 4 3/8" X WOF, SUB-CUT INTO (34) 4 3/8" X 4 3/8" SQUARES
- (4) STRIPS 3 3/8" X WOF, SUB-CUT INTO (36) 3 3/8" X 3 3/8" SQUARES
- (18) STRIPS 2 1/2" X WOF, SUB-CUT (12) OF THE STRIPS INTO:
-(82) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ 1/2"
-(18) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 1/2"
LEAVE 3 REMAINING STRIPS FOR BORDERS


## BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

1. On the wrong side of $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ and $43 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, draw a line along the diagonal. Pair squares with print squares of the same size, and sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of the marked line. Cut along marked line, and trim to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ HSTs*, respectively. Press towards print fabric.

2. For block A, gather (4) coordinating $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ HSTs from step 1 , as well as (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square. Arrange in an "O" shape, as shown. Sew into rows, and press towards as indicated by the arrows. Sew rows together, and press towards the center row. Block will be $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

3. For block B, gather (4) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ various HSTs from step 1. Arrange in pinwheel shape, as shown. Sew into rows, and press seams in opposite directions. Sew rows together, and press seam open. Block will be $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

4. Gather remaining $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing pieces, as well as blocks made in steps $2 \& 3$. Arrange into rows, beginning with cornerstone/sashing row, as shown, followed by a sashing/block row, as shown. Alternate each block row to begin with an "o" or a pinwheel block.

6.Sew border strips together, and cut (2) @ 2 1/2" $\times 54$ 1/2" and (2) @ $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew long borders to each side of the quilt top, and press towards border. Sew remaining borders to top and bottom, and press towards border.

## 7. Quilt and bind as desired.

Finished baby quilt size: $42^{\prime \prime} \times 58^{\prime \prime}$
5. Sew into rows, pressing each row towards sashing pieces. Sew rows together and press rowards sashing rows.
