## First Snow

FINISHED BLOCK 12" X 12"

## FABRIC CUTS

FROM EACH 10" SQUARE, CUT: FROM $51 / 2$ yards BACKGROUND FABRIC, CUT:

- (4) 3 1/2" $\times 3$ 1/2"
- (5) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 1/2"
- 28 @ $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF, sub-cut (336) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- 22 @ 5 1/2" $\times$ WOF, sub-cut (168) 5 1/2" $\times 5$ 1/2",
(168) $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

1. Gather all the background squares and all the print squares. Lay out into rows, as shown.

2. Sew top and bottom sections together, then sew block into rows, and press toward print fabric.

3. Sew rows together, matching seams. Press toward center row. Rotate the block 45 degrees, and carefully square up the block to $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

4. Arrange into 7 rows, with 6 blocks in each row. Sew rows together, and press seams in opposite directions. Sew rows together, and press in one direction.
